no evangelist can save us, because none of them died for us.

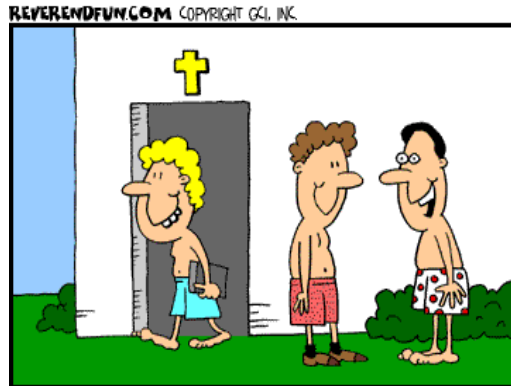
