

A Call to Persevere

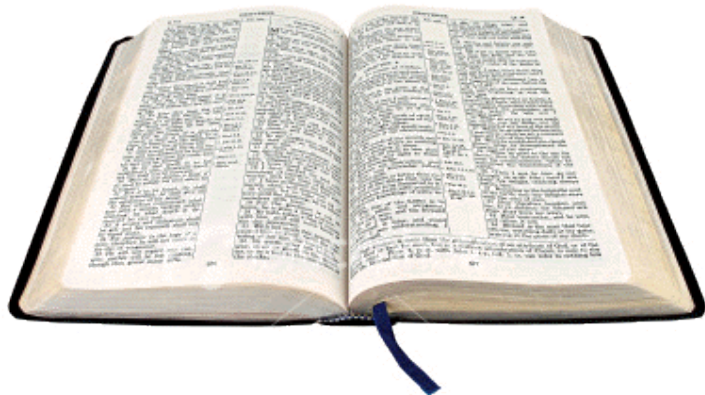
