

As you are probably aware it is only 5 weeks until the mission starts. We really do need lots of you to help and support us this year especially since we are trying out the new idea of using the Felpham Community School premises in the morning and then our church and halls in the afternoon and evening. There are various ways you could help and these are just a couple of them (more coming in next weeks)

1. We are in need of people to help with the catering for the helpers at the mission. Is there anyone who could take responsibility for this (it doesn't mean you would have to be there all the time) you could get a team together and do one or two lunches each and perhaps a dinner each. We also need people to volunteer to help with the lunches and dinners. There will be a sign up sheet in the coffee lounge outside of the kitchen. Lunches can be as simple as sandwiches or a salad or even pizza and would need to cater for about 30 people. Dinners are slightly more substantial and some type of cooked meal would be good, this would be for about 20 people. Please think and pray about this and sign up if you could help.
2. We need more helpers to work with the children, helping with craft and general supervision. This would be on any morning or on Tuesday and Friday afternoon when we have family afternoons. If you think you could spare even one morning or afternoon we would love to hear from you.
3. We need people to work behind the scenes cutting out our craft and other things like that. This could be done in your own home in your own time with the materials delivered and collected!
4. Most importantly we need your prayers and support. Please pray for everyone at the mission, the helpers, the children and the families. Please also try and come to the services at the beginning and end of the mission (Sunday 31st July afternoon and Friday 5th August in the afternoon) there will be more details on these later but please put the dates in your diaries.
